Butterflies and Moths:

<p>Common Blue (Female is brown) April – October</p> <p>Larva feeds on clover & trefoils.</p>	<i>Polyommatus icarus</i>	  
<p>Large White April – October</p> <p>Larva feeds on brassica family.</p>	<i>Pieris brassicae</i>	
<p>Meadow Brown May – September</p> <p>Larva feeds on grasses Overwinters in base of grasses</p>	<i>Maniola jurtina</i>	

<p>Orange Tip (Female is white) April – June</p> <p>Caterpillars eat garlic mustard, lady's smock, sweet rocket & honesty</p> <p>Overwinters as a chrysalis in shrubs or trees.</p>	<p>Anthocharis cardamines</p>	
<p>Peacock March – May and July – September</p> <p>Caterpillars live only on Nettles</p> <p>Adult butterflies overwinter in sheds or cracks in trees.</p>	<p>Inachis io</p>	
<p>Ringlet June – July</p> <p>Caterpillars feed on grasses and overwinter at the base of grasses.</p>	<p>Aphantopus hyperantus</p>	
<p>Six-spot Burnet Moth June - August</p> <p>Caterpillars feed on and overwinter in Bird's-foot trefoil</p>	<p>Zygaena filipendulae</p>	
<p>Small Heath May – September</p> <p>Caterpillars feed on and overwinters in grasses</p>	<p>Coenonympha pamphilus</p>	

Fungi:
